2. Since your horse cannot verbally express how he/she is feeling, we suggest that you monitor your horse(s) behavior during the times when they are wearing the leg wraps. While the majority of horses will enjoy the therapeutic sensation and relax, some horses wearing the leg wraps may experience higher levels of sensitivity due to the increase in circulation and releasing of toxins.



PROLOTEX™ Far Infrared Quilted Leg wraps for horses can be used on a daily basis allowing treatment to take place around the clock.

Special stitch design eliminates chafing. Rounded corners. Poly/cotton blend shell is pre-shrunk. Foam padded and half lined with PROLOTEX™ fabric.

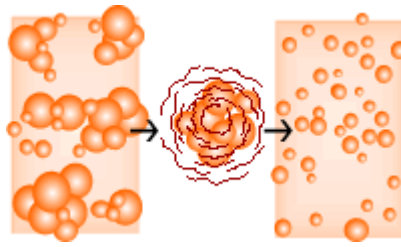

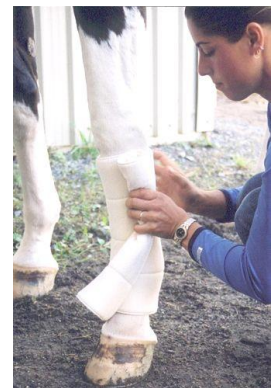
